Qualification: You must be a registered resident or foreign resident of Minamisoma.

(This includes those who evacuated outside the city without changing their certificate of residence.

※No age restrictions.)

Annual fee: ¥500 per person.

Mutual aid period: From April 1st to March 31st of the following year.

Vaccinations and Targeted Age Range

● Rotavirus (Implemented from October, 2020)

Type 1	6 weeks to 24 weeks
Type 5	6 weeks to 32 weeks

● Hepatitis B

Under 1 year old

● Influenza Type B

2 months to 5 years old

● PCV (Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine)

2 months to 5 years old

● Diphtheria, Whooping Cough, Tetanus, and Polio

3 months to 7 1/2 years old

● BCG (Tuberculosis Vaccine)

Under 1 year old

● Measles and Rubella

First Shot	1 to 2 years old
Second Shot	1 year before becoming 5 - 7 years old and before entering school.

● Chickenpox

1 to 3 years old

● Japanese Encephalitis

First Shot	6 months to 7 1/2 years old
Second Shot	9 to 13 years old

● Diphtheria and Tetanus

Second Shot	11 to 12 years old
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● Cervical Cancer Prevention (Human Papillomavirus Infection)

6th grade elementary school to 1st grade high school girls.
