Please note the following

Smartphones

- Device that can read your My Number Card (NFC Type B compatible device)
- iOS 13.7 version or newer
- Android OS 8.0 version or newer

Other Necessary Documents

- A My Number Card and its 4-digit pin (PIN code to assist you in entering the information that you set when you obtained your My Number Card)
- (For those who want to use it overseas) Passport


Scan My Number Card

Choose whether you want to use app **domestically** or **overseas**.

Enter the 4-digit pin you created when you received your My Number Card. If you input it wrong 3 times, you will be locked out.

Hold your My Number Card close to your smartphone. Please note that the place up to which you hold your phone differs depending on the phone model.

Enter the municipality that your certificate of residence is in. If you moved between the 1st and 2nd dose, enter the correct municipalities for both.

Please check to make sure all your information is correct. If there are any mistakes, please go to your local city hall office general service counter.

With the click of a button you can display your vaccination records whenever and wherever you want.
