### Type Collection

### How to Throw Away

**Burnable Trash**

Trash collection site  
Put in a designated trash bag and write your trash number.

●Kitchen waste (food scraps, shells, eggshells, etc.) ※Drain any liquid ※Break sharp end off sticks or toothpicks ●Rubber (gloves, hose, sandals, etc.) ●Paper diapers ※Remove waste and wrap in paper ●Leather (shoes, bags, wallets, etc.) ●Paper scraps (tissues, photos, paper cups) ●Cloth (old clothes, towels, cushions, etc.) ●Plastic (excluding containers/packaging) ●Pet litter (market goods) ●Cooking oil (soak up with paper/cloth, or use congealing ingredient to harden)

Help prevent trash from being scattered, e.g. by animals, by using the nets at your collection site

※Don't put in designated bag ●Tree branches / Bamboo ※Logs 5cm thick and 50cm long or less ※Split bamboo (Tie in bundle with string to dispose)

**Nonburnable Trash**

Trash collection site  
Put in a designated trash bag and write your trash number.

●Glass (glass tableware, mirrors, medicine bottles, etc.) ●Ceramics (tea cups, flower pots, etc.) ●Edged objects (razors, knives, scissors)  
●Metal (pots, kettles, frying pans, etc.) ●Lightbulbs (incandescent lightbulbs, fluorescent lamp starters, etc.) ●Small household electronics (rice cookers, irons, electric kettles, hairdryers, etc.) ●Umbrellas (tie shut with string) ※remove cloth and put it with burnables

※Wrap dangerous broken or sharp objects in thick paper and indicate hazard (危険) on the designated bag. Don't include explosive or incendiary material.

**Dangerous/hazardous material disposal**

●Spray cans/gas cylinders ※Use up contents, and use specialized tool to make a hole in a safe and well-ventilated area outside; dispose in a clear plastic bag ●Fluorescent tubes ※Dispose unbroken in replacement's box ●Batteries and mercury thermometers ※Put in clear plastic bag together ●Lighters ※Use up contents and dispose in clear plastic bag

**Plastic Containers/Packaging**

Recyclables collection site  
Put in a clear plastic bag (up to 45 liters)  
No collection on holidays

●Eligible Items  
• Caps and labels from plastic bottles • Plastic bags  
• Plastic food containers • Detergent bottles, etc. (rinsed)  
• Plastic egg cartons

●Points to Note  
1. Look for the Plastic Mark 2. Rinse off any dirty parts  
3. If you can't find the mark, or the item is stained, throw it away in burnable trash  
Items that would take a lot of time and effort to wash can be put with burnable trash (Retort food packs, natto containers, etc.)

Look for this Plastic Mark

**Paper**

Recyclables collection site  
Sort papers by type, and tie together with string.

●Newspaper (Including inserted flyers) ●Magazine paper (Including textbooks and notebooks) ●Cardboard ●Paper packs (Remove any alum. coating, Wash out interior) ●Other (Misc.) (Candy boxes, wrapping, etc.)

**Do not mix with the following**  
Glued paper, plastic coated paper, wax coated paper, photos, oil paper, water-resistant paper, print paper, thermal paper, insulation paper, coupon paper, carbonless copy paper, carbon-backed paper, synthetic paper

**Important points**  
●Burning waste in a metal drum or an incinerator that does not meet standards is prohibited by law.  
●If trash is not put out properly, or trash the city does not collect is put out, the bag will be labeled with a trash violation

**Bottles**

Recyclables collection site  
Put in blue container (box) without sorting by color.

●Empty bottles (Used for food/drinks/makeup)  
※Remove the cap, empty contents, and rinse out with water  
※Return beer bottles and 1800cc bottles to the store or to a recycle company

**Recyclable Appliances** Contact the store or a collection company.  
●AC Unit ●TV ●Fridge/Freezer ●Washing/Drying Machine  
※Collection, transportation, and recycling fees apply

**Computers** Contact the computer maker.  
●Desktop ●Laptop ●CRT display PC ●Liquid crystal display PC  
※For computers without the PC Recycle mark, recycling fees will apply.

※Laptops can be put in the small electronic device collection boxes.

**Cans**

Recyclables collection site  
Put in yellow container (box) without sorting aluminum from steel.

●Empty cans (Used for food/drinks)  
※Empty contents and rinse out with water.

**Bulky Trash, Large Quantities, Business-Related Trash**  
●Items that won't fit in designated bag, e.g. bicycles, furniture, futons  
●Trash from moving, spring cleaning, pruning trees, etc.  
●Trash from industrial activity, e.g. stores, offices, restaurants, farms

Drop off at the Clean Haramachi Center, or contact the collection company nearest you.

**PET Bottles, White Trays**

Recyclables collection site  
Put in collection boxes at supermarkets and convenience stores at any time.

●PET bottles  
※Caps and labels are plastics  
※Stained items are burnables

●Styrofoam trays  
※Colored or patterned trays are plastics

**Dangerous Materials, Difficult-to-Process Items, Building Supplies**  
●Propane tanks, pesticides, waste oil, home medical instruments (e.g. syringes, needles), etc.  
●Tires, car batteries, fire extinguishers, farm-use plastic, etc.  
●Lumber, roof tiles, cement blocks, debris, etc.

Contact the store or a nearby collection company.

Trash the City Will Not Collect (See Garbage Guidebook for details)

Do not take to trash collection sites.
